

**Wichita and Affiliated Tribes**  
**Driveway Program**  
(Gravel and Tinhorn Service)

The Driveway Program was established in January of 2020 as an added service to the tribe's list of programs that provides gravel and tinhorn needs for tribal members that reside within the Tribal Jurisdictional boundaries or Anadarko Rural Area.

**The purpose.....**

The program is designed to assist tribal members with driveway improvements that will need restructuring/ over-hauling, new construction, or driveways that need repair that have minor wear and tear such as pot holes, shallow gravel, and wash boards/ rivets, etc. Driveway improvements will provide a safer, ease of access to the resident's property/ home.

**The process.....**

**Phase I** (Assessment) determining your driveway needs

**Phase II** (Service Application) Pre-work outline of work to be performed

**Phase III** (Work Order) begins the work on driveway improvements from start to finish

**What qualifies you.....**

- Be an enrolled member of the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes
- Be the owner of your home/ property (must provide a Property Deed or other legal document that shows proof of ownership)
- Reside in the home
- Live in a rural residential area within the tribal jurisdictional boundaries or Anadarko rural area
- Provide a clear copy of your CDIB or a Tribal Enrollment Letter
- Provide a copy of your utility bill (must have your name included)
- Complete and submit an Address Form (to be used for assessment and inventory of your driveway)

Forms and applications for the service may be picked up in the Transportation Department office located at the Tribal Headquarters or they can be emailed or mailed and returned by hand deliver or mail in its original form.
