

New Registration Requirements & Information

To register a vehicle with the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes, all of the following eligibility requirements must be met:

- The registered owner must be an enrolled member of the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes.
- Must reside within the State of Oklahoma
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- The registered owner must possess a valid Oklahoma driver's license. (No permits or Intermediate)
- The vehicle must be titled in the name of the enrolled tribal member.
- Current insurance must be provided and must list the enrolled tribal member as the insured.
- Any lienholder information must be properly disclosed and documented.

Please note:

All new vehicle registrations must be completed in person only to verify eligibility, ownership, and documentation. Same day processing is not guaranteed.

Required Documents

Please bring all original documents required for vehicle registration. Vehicles cannot be registered if documentation is incomplete or missing.

You must provide:

- Original vehicle title or Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (We do not accept electronic titles)
 - Title must be fully completed (all buyer information filled in)
 - Notarized when required
- Valid Oklahoma driver's license of the registered owner
- Current insurance verification card
 - The enrolled tribal member must be listed on the insurance policy as the policyholder or named insured.
- Wichita and Affiliated Tribes enrollment card
- Lienholder information, if applicable
- Bill of Sale
- Payment for all applicable taxes and registration fees, including:
 - Registration fee
 - Convenience fee for credit/debit card payments

Important Registration Policy Notice

- The enrolled tribal member must be listed on the original vehicle title exactly as issued.
- Names may not be added, altered, or written in after the fact, including changes made in different handwriting or ink.
- The enrolled tribal member listed on the title must be present at the time of registration.
- Spouses, parents, children, or other individuals may not register a vehicle on behalf of an enrolled tribal member.

Any title showing alterations or missing required information will not be accepted, and the registration will be delayed or the appointment rescheduled.

The Tag Office reserves the right to refuse service if documentation cannot be verified or if requirements are not met.

Lien & Title Holding Policy

If your vehicle has a lien, please note that the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes is a title-holding tribe.

For all vehicles registered with the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes that have an active lien:

- The Tribal title will be mailed directly to the lienholder.
- The registered owner will be provided a non-certified copy of the title for their records.

Lost or Stolen Plate or Decal

In the event that a license plate and/or decal is lost or stolen, it is the responsibility of the Tribal member to notify the Tag Office immediately. The Tribal member must also contact local law enforcement and provide a police report or official statement documenting the loss or theft.

Replacement fees are as follows:

- **Replacement license plate:** \$5.00
- **Replacement decal:** \$5.00
